

NEW HAMPSHIRE FFA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The NH FFA Foundation may annually award a scholarship to be known as the New Hampshire FFA Foundation Scholarship to a deserving young man or woman. General conditions pertaining to this scholarship are as follows:

Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship shall be to encourage the continued educational pursuits of a young person in the broad field of agriculture by granting financial aid in support of this endeavor.

Amount: The scholarship shall consist of at least \$500 to be awarded annually. Checks are made payable to the student and school upon verification of enrollment in a recognized university, college or vocational school.

Eligibility: This scholarship shall be available to all students who are members in good standing of the Granite State FFA and who are pursuing or intending to pursue their education beyond high school with a major in the broad area of agriculture or forestry. Applicants must submit the information requested on the application form in order to be eligible for consideration.

Selection

Procedure: The recipient of the scholarship will be selected by a committee appointed by the NH FFA Advisory Council. The primary criteria of selection will consist of FFA participation, educational achievement and potential, financial need, and an indication of the applicant's career goals. Award notification is made at the annual FFA state convention.

Amendment &

Termination: The Board of Trustees of the NH FFA Foundation may at their sole discretion amend or terminate the provisions of the scholarship at any time as they see fit.
